AGENCY'S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

The College of Charleston (hereafter, "the College"), including its component, the University of Charleston, South Carolina, has long been required by its regional accreditor and various secondary accreditors to have a strategic planning process. In May 2020, the College Board of Trustees adopted a new strategic plan, *Tradition & Transformation*, with a focus on three main pillars: 1) Student Success; 2) Academic Distinction; and 3) Employee Success. Campus leaders created several metrics in order to chart the progress and effective implementation of the plan, such as retention rates, graduation rates, participation rates for experiential learning, acceptance rates, employee turnover rates and the Great Colleges to Work For survey results, to name but a few. The 10-year strategic plan and its metrics are posted at https://strategic-plan.cofc.edu/.

Fiscal year 2023–2024 represented President Andrew Hsu's fifth year in leadership at the College of Charleston. He made the 10-year strategic plan a priority of his administration from Day One, and has coalesced his senior leadership team around the implementation of the strategic plan's deliverables as well as the plan's vision for the institution to become a national university redefining a liberal arts education. Each investment, each new initiative is linked to how it will impact and help the institution better realize its goals in those three pillars.

Accountability is central to a properly run institution of higher education. Fortunately, the College of Charleston does considerable work on this front, both from compliance with state regulations as well as accreditation requirements from the Southern Association of College and Schools, Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC).

College leaders rely on the strategic plan to guide them in their annual process for budgetary development. All department, school, office, and divisional budget requests must be aligned with one or more of the plan's strategies and in support of one of the pillars. The strategic plan has proven an effective roadmap. That adherence to a fiscally conservative approach has allowed the College of Charleston to become more efficient in its cost structure and to build an institutional reserve, no small feat in today's higher education landscape.

For the 2024 Accountability Report, the College has provided its mission, goals and objectives, performance measures and appropriate information on program areas, associated with expenditures, financial and performance measures for those areas, which are all statutory requirements. This report falls in line with the College of Charleston Administration's dedication to transparency, accountability and desire to show return on investment. In this report, reviewers will note alignment of the agency strategic plan with individual unit goals as well as manager performance responsibilities and individual performance goals. All parts connect.

As reviewers will see in the provided data, the story at the College of Charleston is one of a university with tremendous forward momentum – a university that has reversed a downward trend regarding its relevance and financial health. Measures that need to be trending up are doing so: such as enrollments, revenues and employee satisfaction. And measures that need to be better controlled and held steady, such as expenses, are being managed in a way to keep the business enterprise in the black.

The College's 10-year strategic plan touches upon many of the Statewide Enterprise Objectives, such as Education, Training and Human Development; Public Infrastructure and Economic Development; and Government and Citizens. Most important, the College of Charleston is delivering on the stated goal for South Carolina students to engage in personalized learning opportunities and attain world-class knowledge, skills and characteristics to be successful after graduation and into their careers. By doing so, the College is integral and plays a part in the state's efforts to improve educational infrastructure and elevate the levels of educational preparedness of every South Carolinian. By providing these educational opportunities, the College of Charleston improves the quality of life for so many, which has had an impact both in the present and future. The College of Charleston also serves as a magnet for talent, helping its particular region attract businesses, investment, innovation and visitors.




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
AGENCY ORGANIZATIONAL CHART




















