Scholarship awards are contingent upon available funds.

Renewal Criteria

In order to retain an institutional scholarship, you must:

- Earn and maintain a cumulative 3.5 CofC GPA on a 4.0 scale;
- Earn a minimum of 30 hours during the academic year (fall, spring, and summer terms.)
 - **NOTE: AP, IB, CLEP, placement and previous year credits do not count towards the annual 30 credit hours requirement

Additional Criteria and Information

- Scholarship recipients must enroll full-time (at least 12 hours per semester) in order to receive any scholarship funds. (EDLS 100: Learning Strategies does not count toward degree requirements or toward registered financial aid hours.) Students dropping below full-time status after the beginning of the semester may be required to return Scholarship funds
- Remain in good standing with the College of Charleston Student Honor Code
- Students must remain continuously enrolled at College of Charleston as a full-time, degree-seeking student. Students with a break in continuous full-time enrollment will forfeit the scholarship.
- Limited to four years from first term of enrollment or until eligible to graduate (whichever comes first). Students can only receive scholarship funds if they are seeking their first degree
- Participate in Donor related activities and make contact upon request
- Colonial Scholarships added to all other aid, from any source, may not exceed the Cost of Attendance, established by the Office of Financial Assistance
- Scholarship funds are only available for the academic year. Any special enrollment periods, classes, or summer school are not funded
- Elective Special Courses with surcharge fees such as horseback riding, sailing, etc., are not covered
- Scholarships will be terminated when the student completes the requirements for their first undergraduate degree
- During the eighth term (term of graduation) of attendance, the Colonial Scholarship may be prorated based on the number of hours enrolled in for that term. Proration will be based on 12 hours in that term.
- A continuing student that has lost eligibility, or that was not previously eligible, cannot regain eligibility
