

2023-2024 Independent Verification

Your 2023–2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) has been selected for a process called verification. Federal law requires that an institution verify certain information that has been listed within the FAFSA before federal aid can be disbursed. To complete the federal verification process, the financial aid office will compare the information that has been listed on your FAFSA to the information listed on this worksheet along with other documents submitted. If there are differences, your FAFSA information will need to be corrected.

- ◆ You and your spouse if you are married, and,
- ◆ Your children, if any, if you will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, or if the child would be required to provide your information if they were completing a FAFSA for 2023-2024. Include children who meet either of the standards, even if they do not live with you, and,
- ◆ Other people if they now live with you and you provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.
- ◆ Provide the name of the college or university (or mark N/A) that each family member will attend between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024. They must be enrolled in a college degree or certificate program, not post-secondary as a high school student.

1. The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool option within your FAFSA.
2. If you cannot use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, you may obtain a Tax Return Transcript using these methods: On-line or by mail at www.irs.gov/Individuals/get-transcript. Order by phone: **1-800-908-9946**.
3. If you DID NOT FILE a tax return: Please provide our office with a Verification of Non-Filing Letter from the IRS for those that did not file a 2021 IRS tax return. Request this letter by contacting the IRS at 1-800-908-9946 or <http://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript> you must also complete the Student Non-Tax Filer form found on Financial Aid downloads form page @ <http://financialaid.cofc.edu/download-forms/index.php>.
4. If you worked AND /OR had taxable income but did not file and are NOT REQUIRED TO FILE: Complete the Student Non-Filer form SNF24 and submit with documentation and IRS Verification of Non-Filer letter if available.
5. If you intend to email or fax your documents, to meet our security protocols, please mark out all but the last 4 of your social security number from all documents. **Always include students name and CofC ID number on documents submitted.**

***If married you should provide information and documentation for you and your spouse, even if you were not married during the 2021 tax year.**
