

## JUSTIFICATION FOR AWARD WITHOUT COMPETITION

Based upon the following determination, the proposed procurement action described below is being procured pursuant to the authority of Section 11-35-1560 of the SC Procurement Code and 19-445.2105 of the Rules and Regulations, 1976 SC Code of Laws.

Why does the governmental body need this item or service: (description of the agency need that this procurement meets):

This item is required to effectively/efficiently control heating and cooling systems on campus via a server based building automation control system with PC interface.

As a sole source procurement for \$ Est. 5 YR: \$1,710,380.00 from (name of sole source contractor): Control Management Inc.

Description of market research Agency has performed to determine the availability of products or services that would meet the Agency's needs:

Market research through Procurement IQ and GovSpend did not provide any findings. However, research using Google found that the control system components and control configuration/programming software and network server are proprietary to Control Management Inc. All parts and services are covered in the service agreement.

Description of supplies, construction, information technology, and/or services Vendor will provide under the contract:

Siemens server based control system with programmable software, with digital and analog inputs/outputs via network devices/switches that communicate with the CMI server. Compatible field components such as sensors, actuators, motor drives, etc.

This sole source is for a five-year period. The estimated annual cost is \$342,076.00 with a total estimated five-year cost of \$1,710,380.00.

Detailed explanation why no other vendor's supplies, construction, information technology, and/or services will meet the needs of the Agency:

The campus control system network, server, system configurations, field switches, field devices are all proprietary to Control Management Inc. and have been established and built upon over a period of 30 years. Another controls service vendor would be required to establish a new controls network that would require installing new equipment, re-configuring the equipment schedules and resets that were established via testing and balancing of various systems. This could take years to achieve the same depth of control we now have.

A large upfront capital expense would be required to purchase the new equipment in addition to the cost to provide the repair/PM service.

In accordance with the South Carolina Consolidated Procurement section 11-35-1560 - Sole Source, the College of Charleston announced the intent to award without Competition. No protests were received.
