## Basics

- Backpack / shoulder bag
- School supplies

- Laundry detergent

- Can opener
- Reusable water bottle

- Combustible fuels
- Decorative or empty alcohol containers
- Pools or hot tubs
- Grills
- Pets
- Space heaters, personal AC
- Halogen lights
- Electric scooters, e-bikes, etc.
- Weapons, firearms or replicas, knives
- Fireworks
- TV-mounting brackets
- Amplified music and drum sets
- LED strip lights
- Extension cords
- Wallpaper of any kind
