<p>1 <i>All MAT teacher candidates will pass two special education Praxis examinations that required for special education licensure in South Carolina. First, all teacher candidates must pass the "Special Education: Core Knowledge and Applications" test (#5354). Second, each teacher candidate will pass one of the appropriate tests that corresponds to his/her disability area focus (either Emotional Disability [#5372], Learning Disability [#5383], or Mental Disability [#5322]).</i></p>	<p><i>Praxis exams</i></p>
