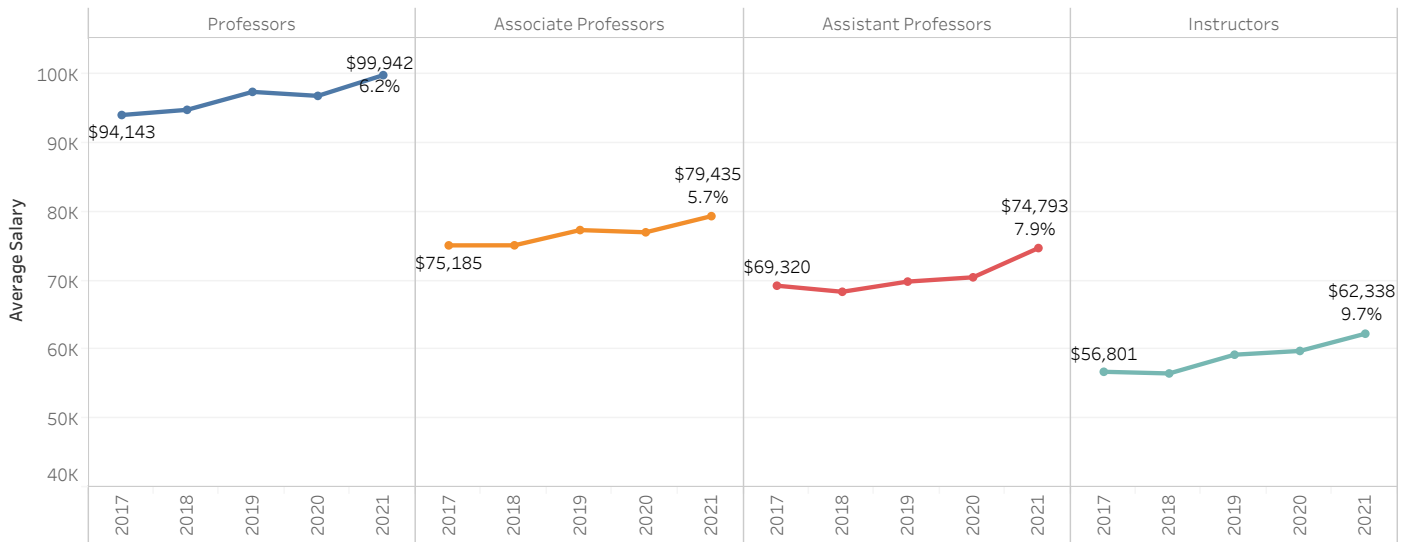

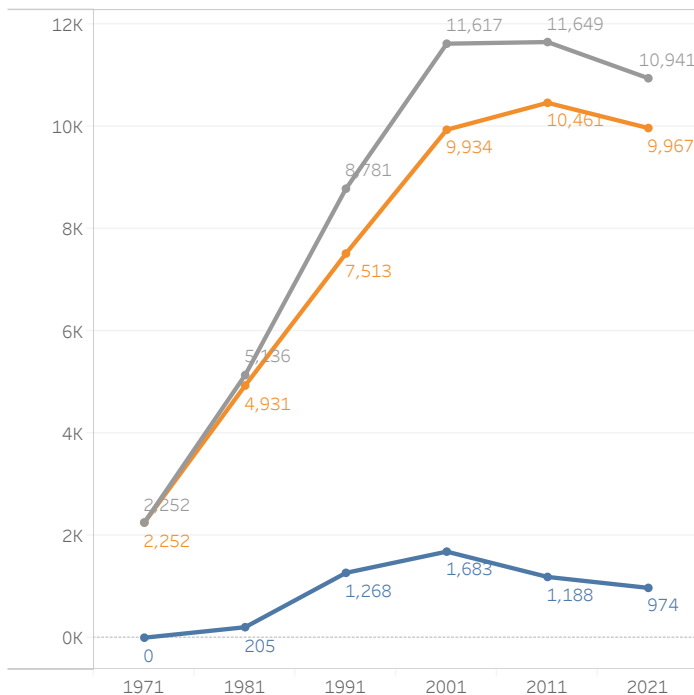

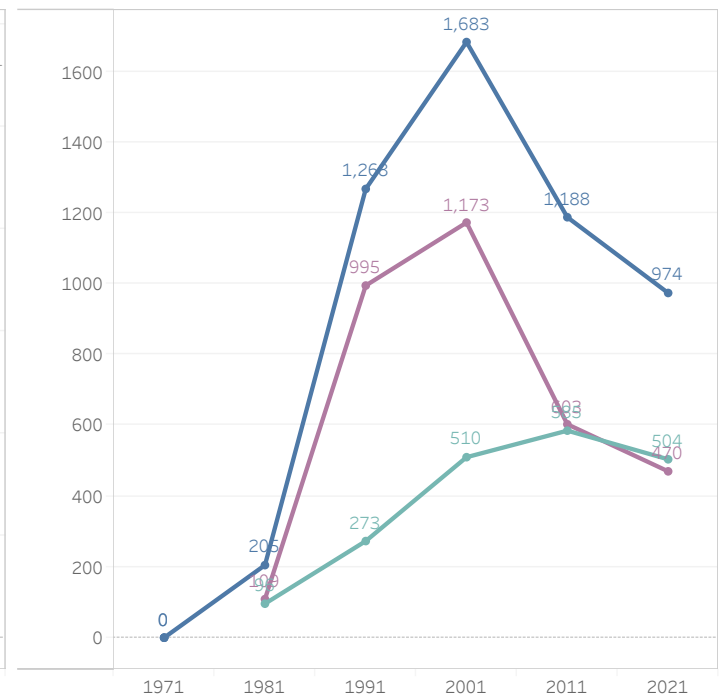

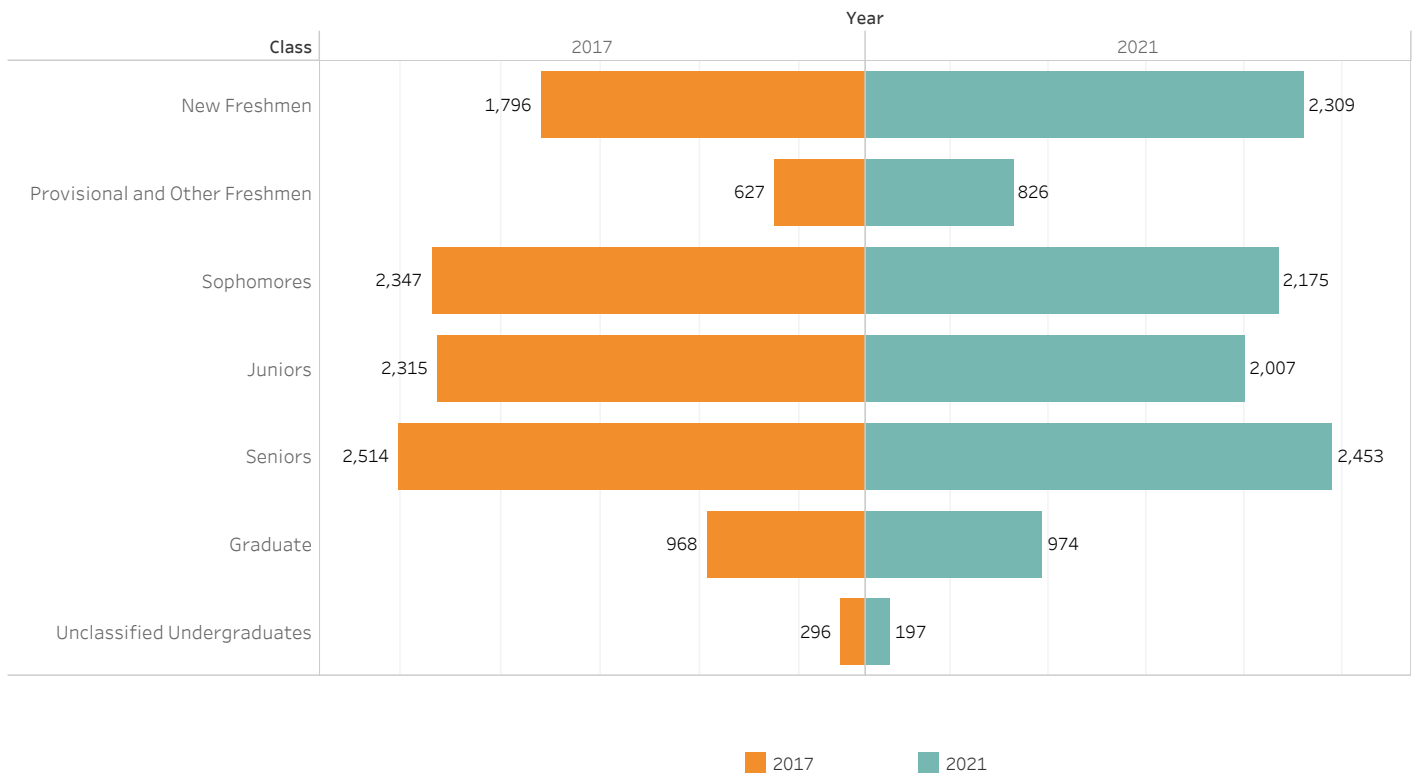

Student Headcounts by Class Comparison



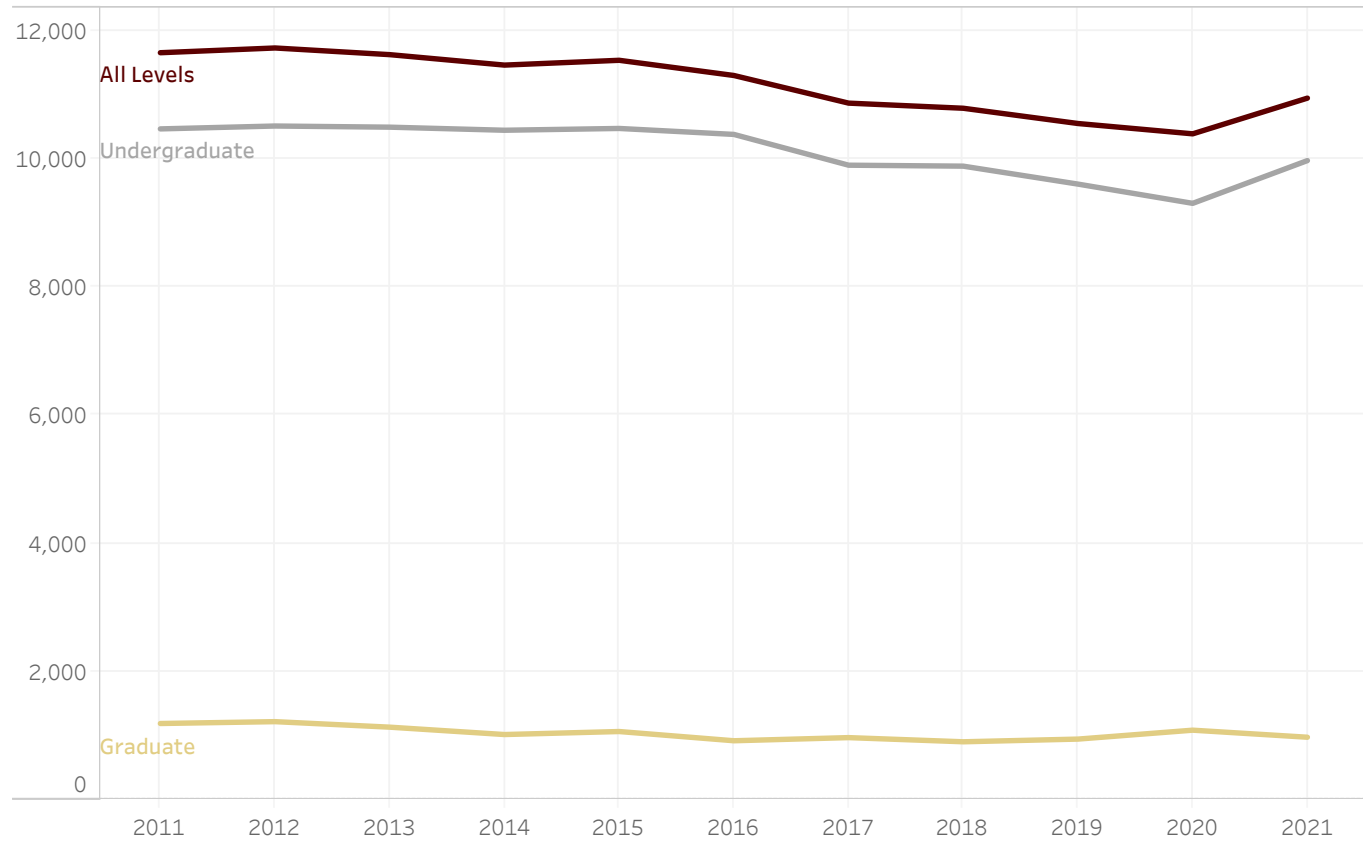

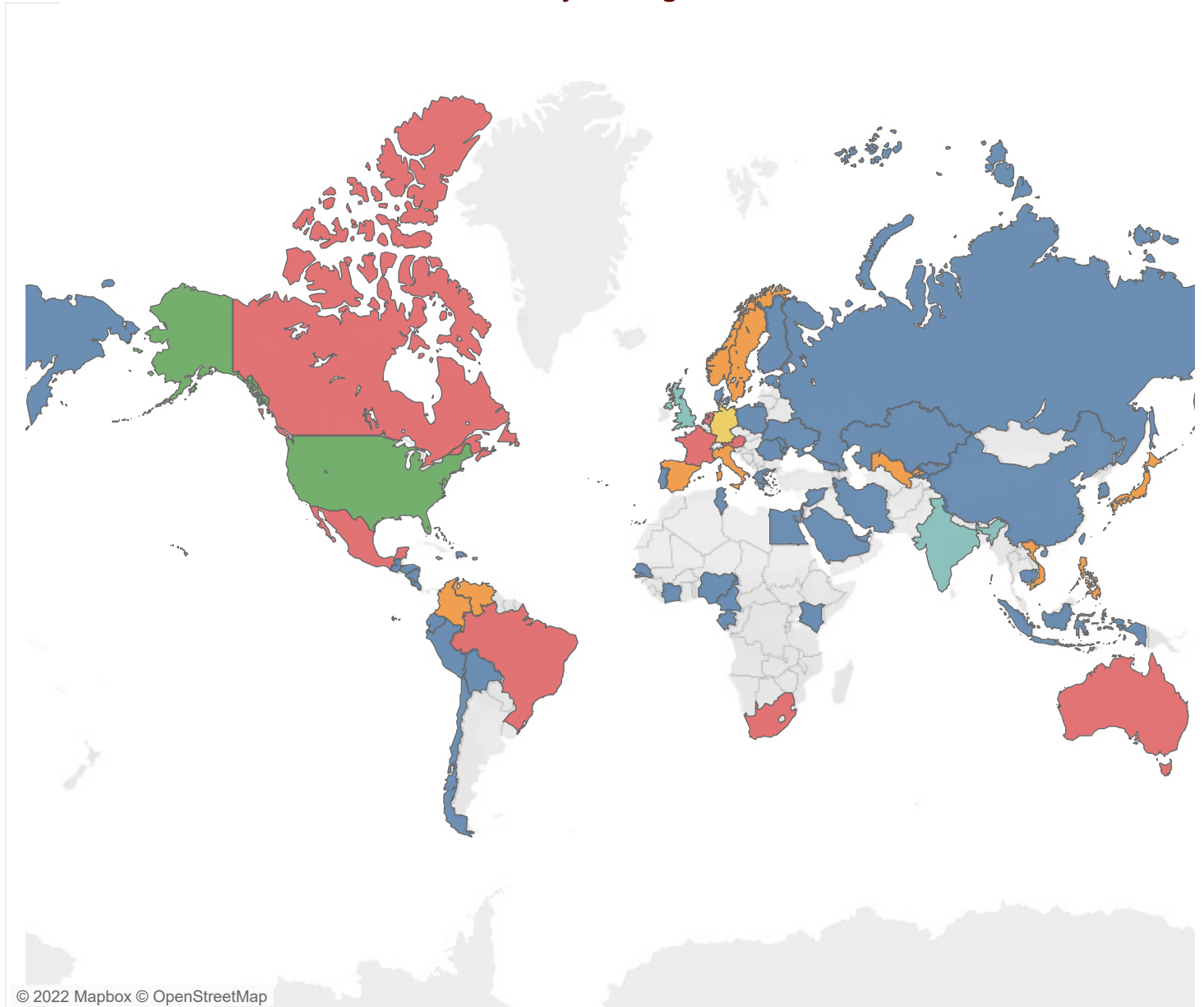

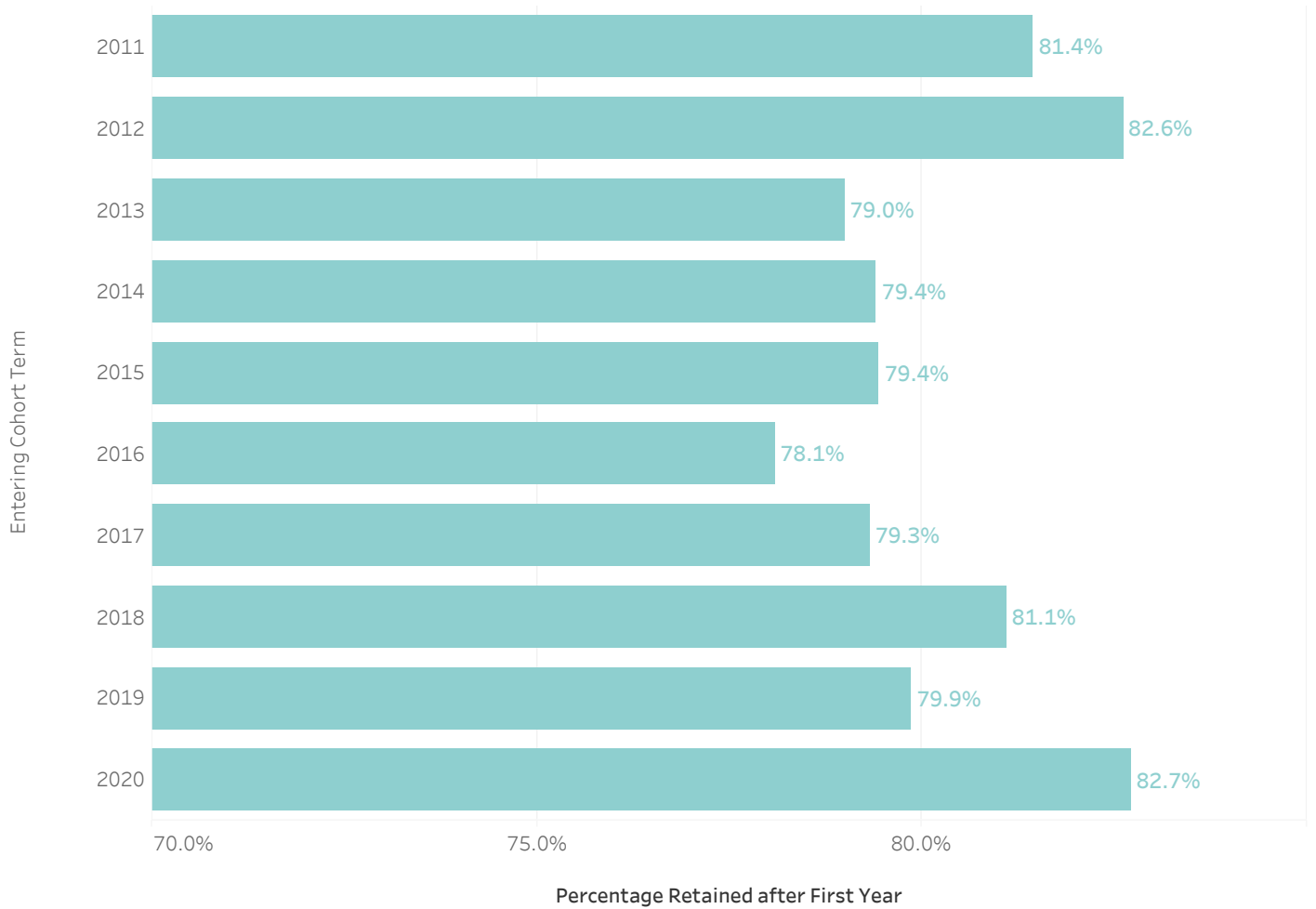

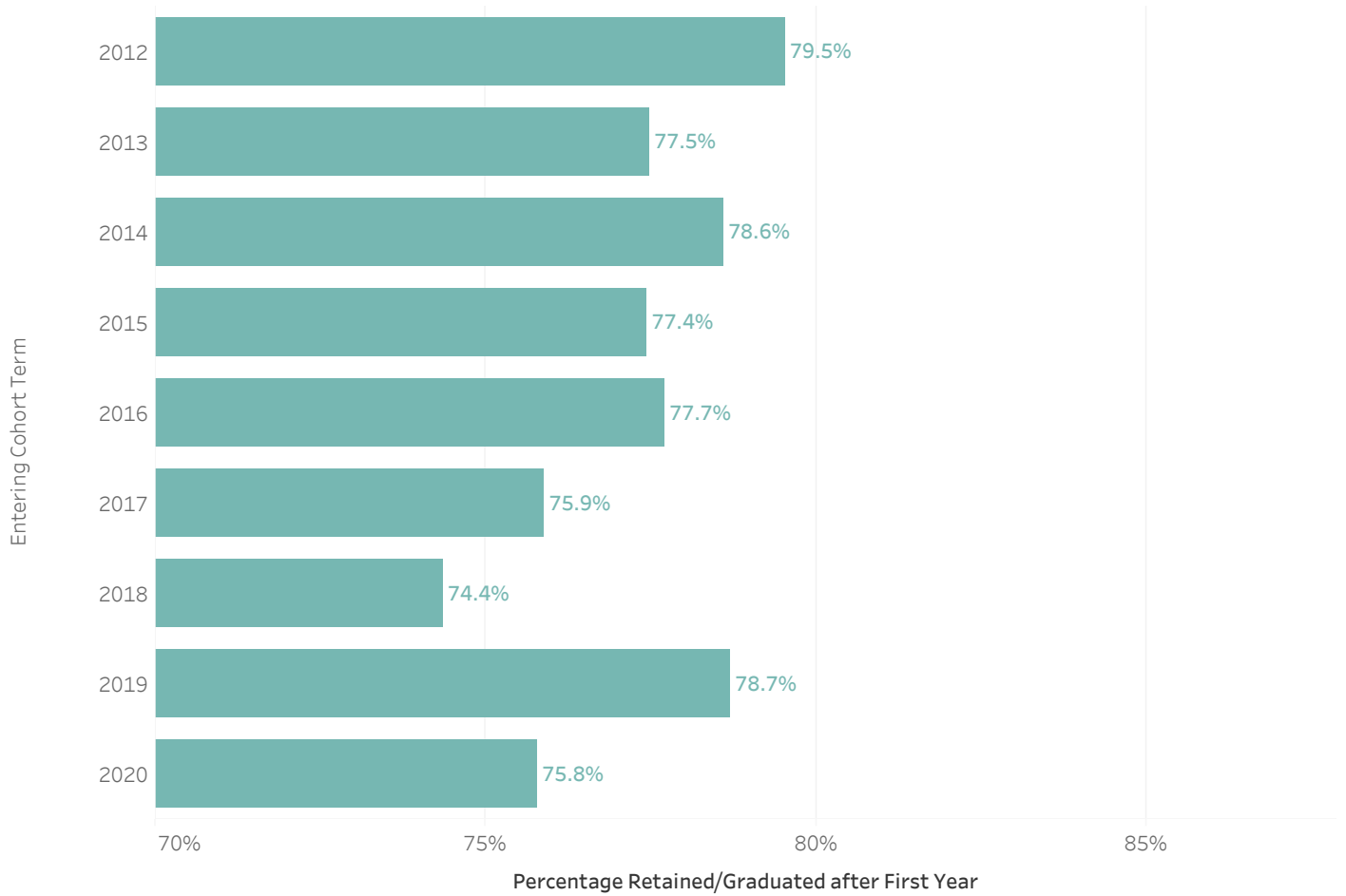

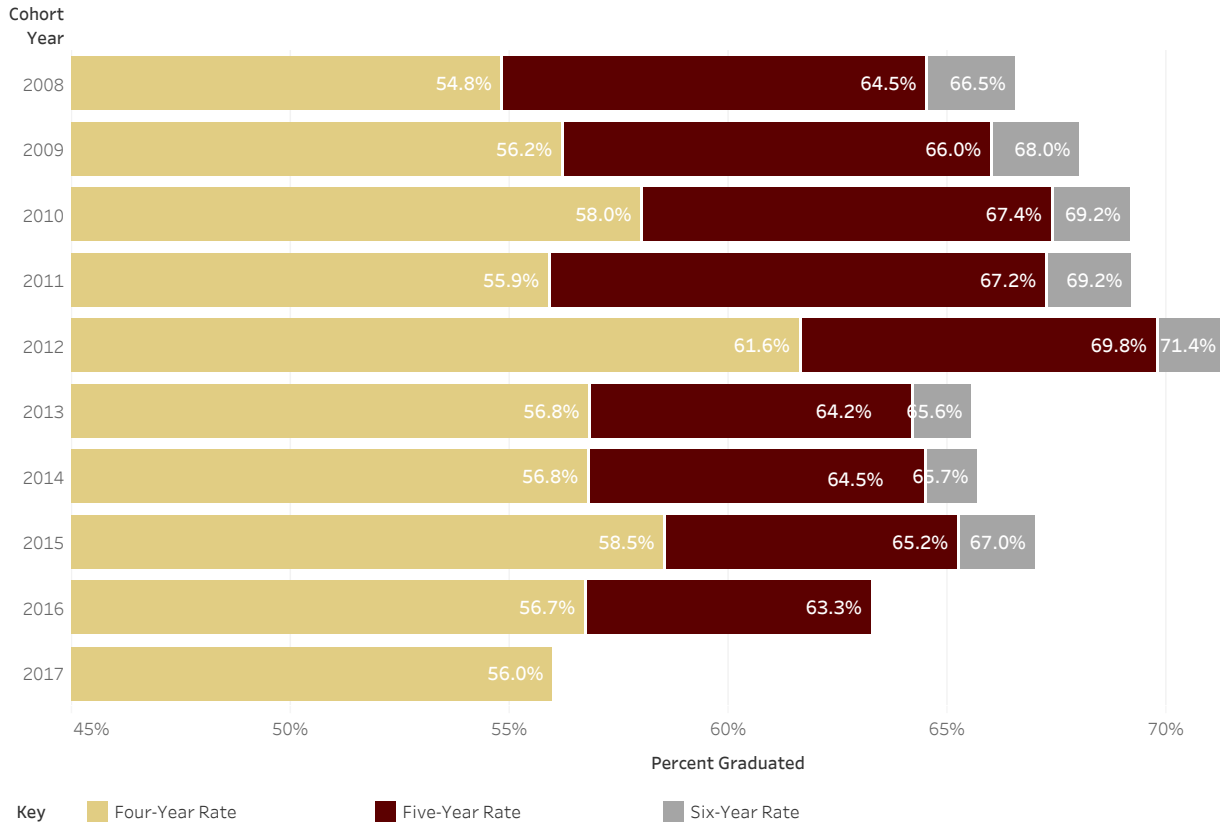
First-Year Retention Rates of New Full-time Freshmen

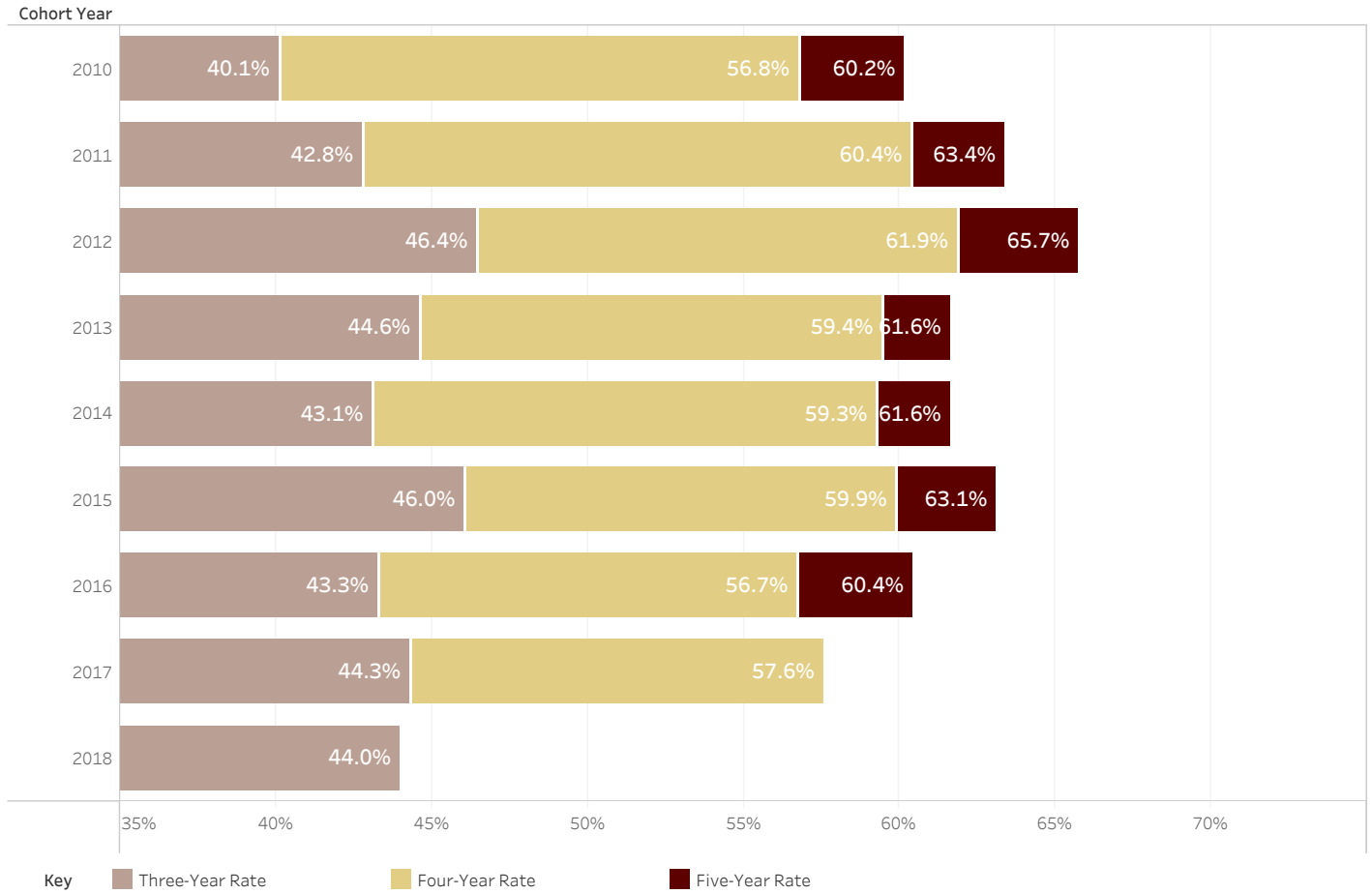

Graduation Rates of New Full-time Transfers

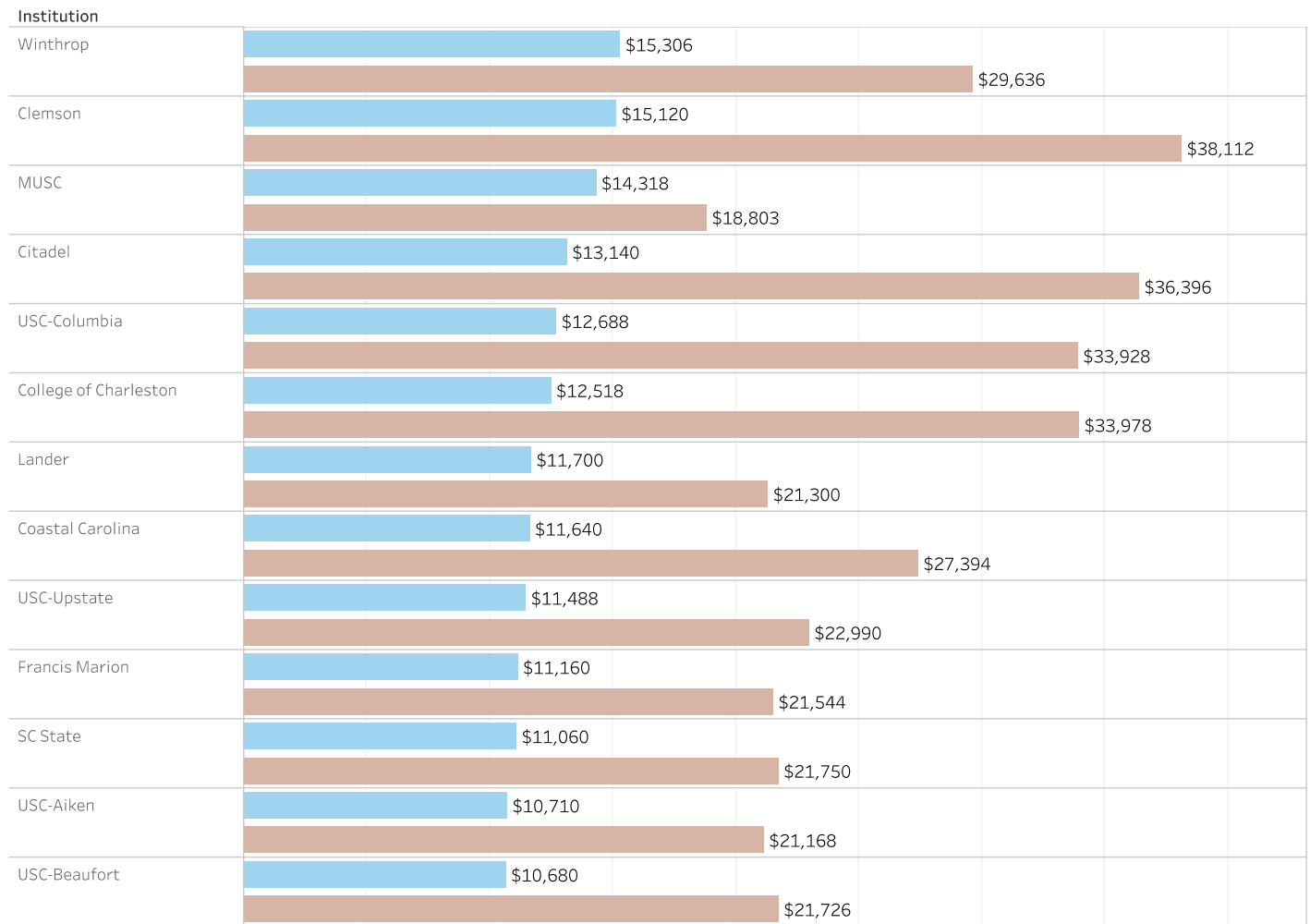

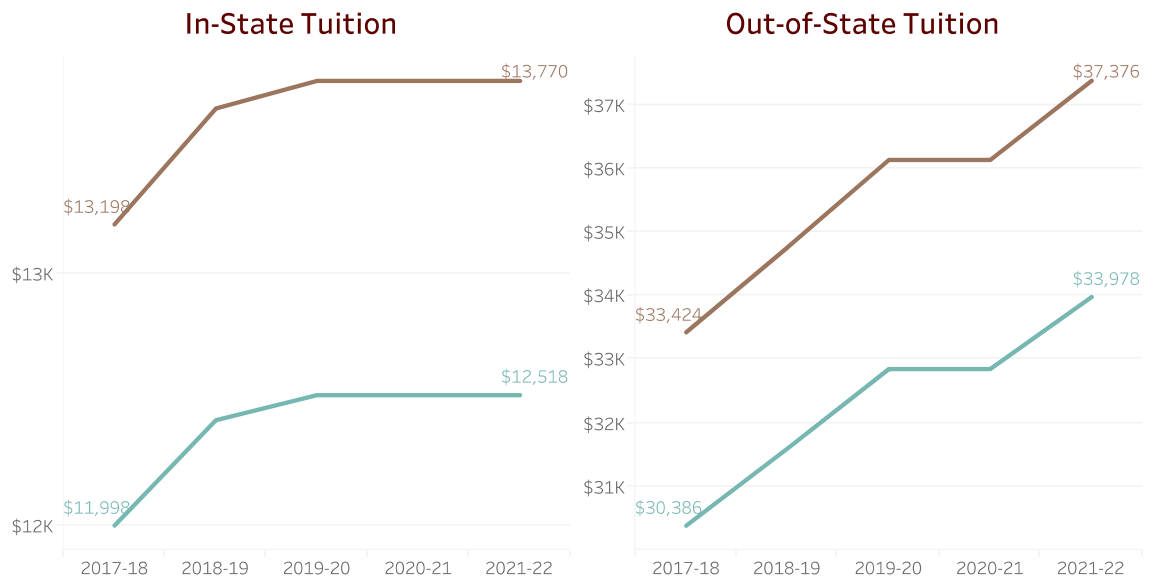

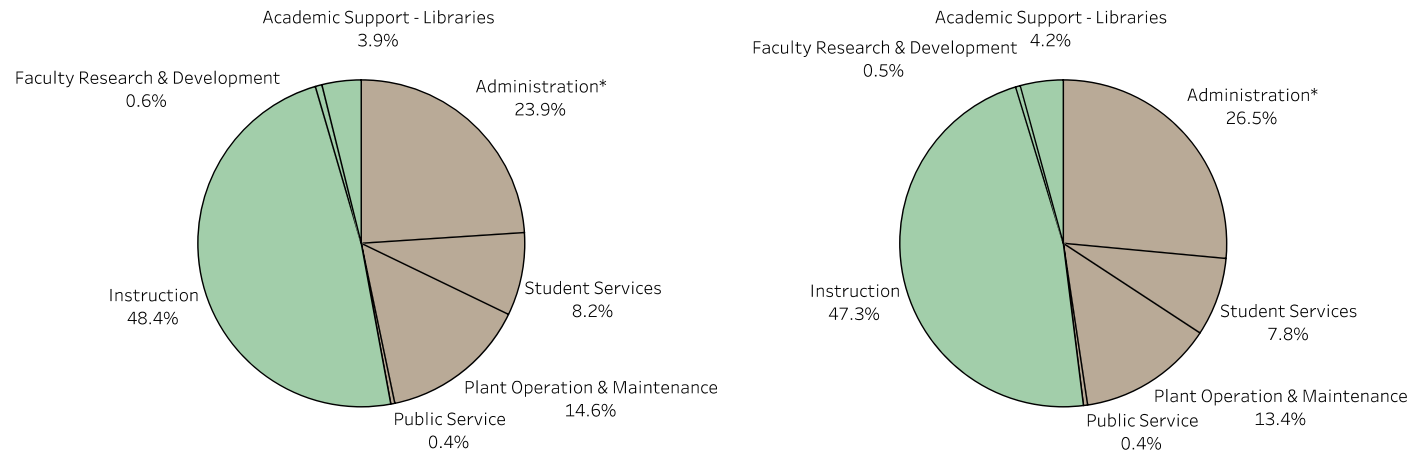
