Photography and Filming: Filming on Campus

Policy Statement

Any person, business or organization wishing to use the College of Charleston campus as a location for commercial film, documentaries, TV or photography must review campus film guidelines and must sign a written campus location agreement prior to permission being granted. For film guidelines and related fees, contact the Office of Institutional Events.

A minimum \$1 million proof-of-insurance certificate must be provided with the College named as additional insured for the day(s) of preparation and shooting.

The City of Charleston Office of Cultural Affairs oversees the permitting process for motion picture, television and still photographic projects throughout the City of Charleston. The College of Charleston works in conjunction with the city, particularly with respect to locations that are intersected by public streets and sidewalks.
