

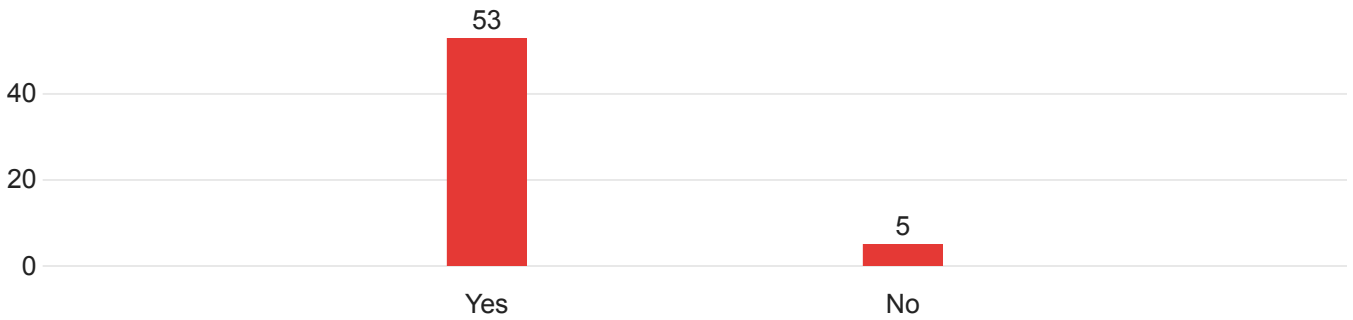
2020 Alumni Survey

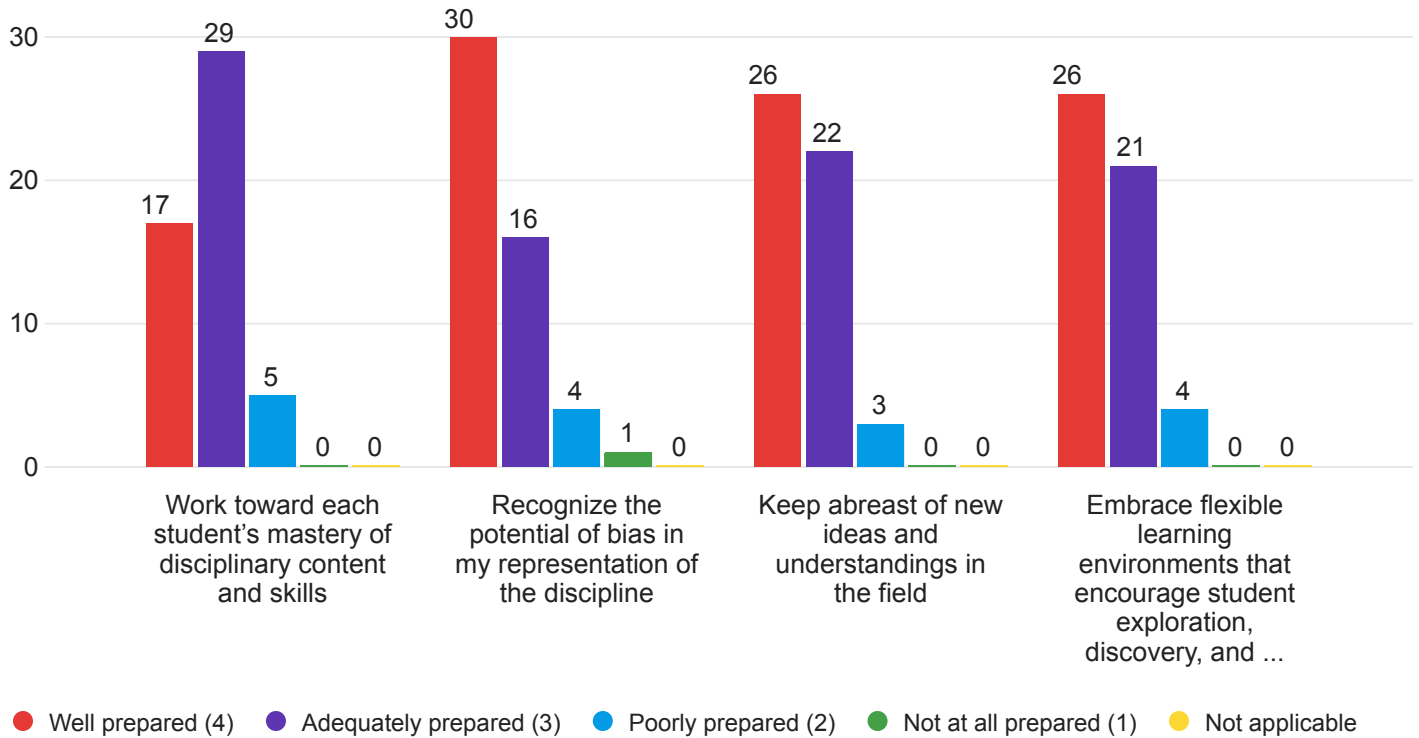

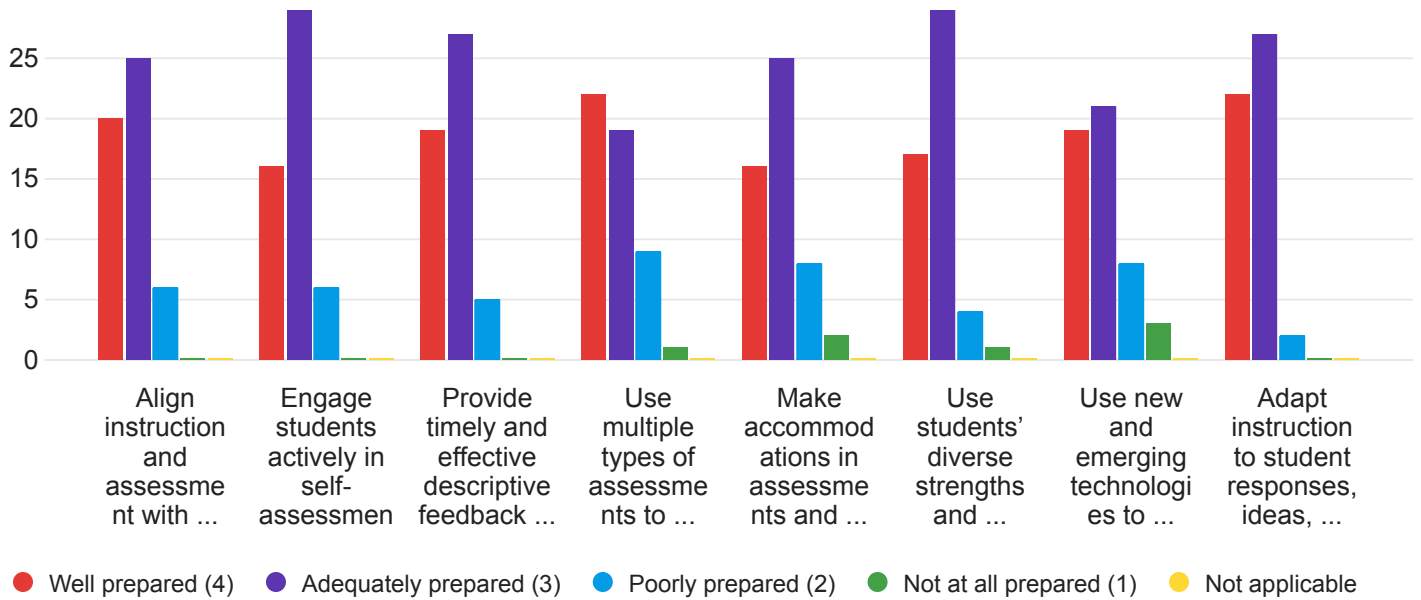

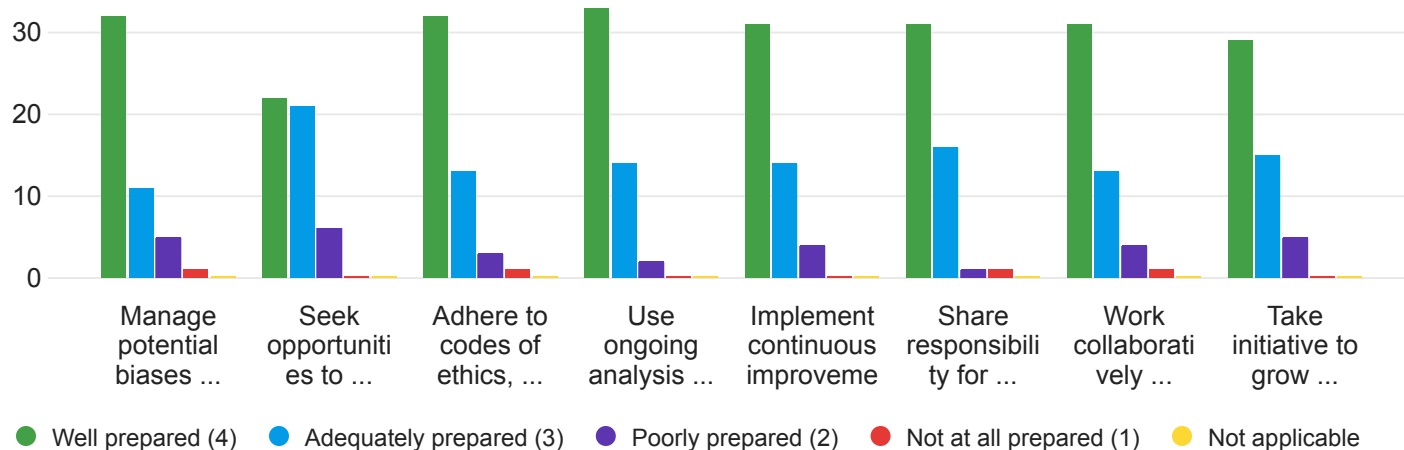

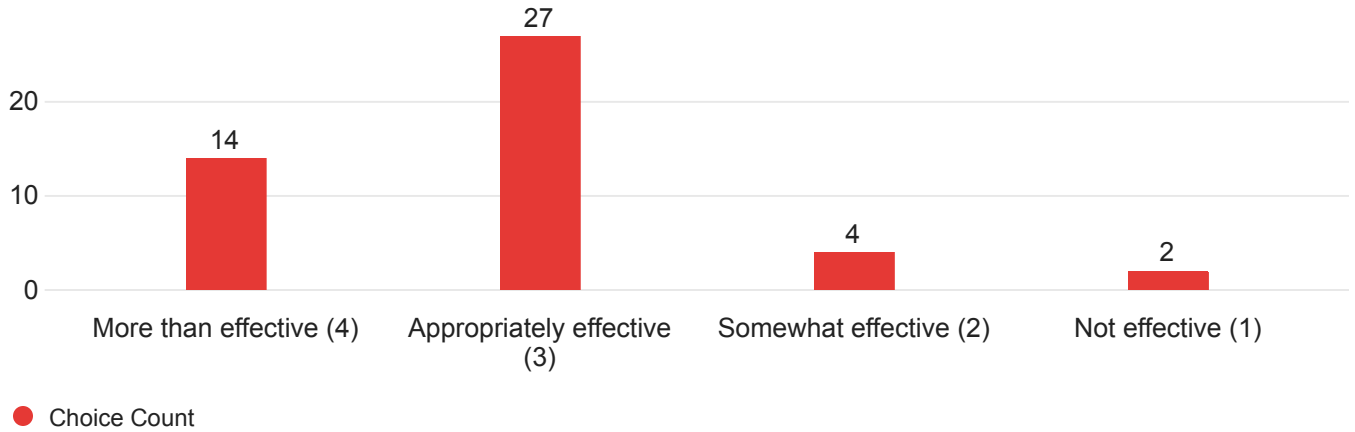
